
How to draw GRUMP[] BIRD

(and stuff)

I thought it would be fun to offer a small guide to my GRUMPY BIRD books, published by Scholastic Press. This is obviously a simplified version of my techniques, but most of it is here.

I make my drawings by combining small groups of things together like BIRD (and his friends), some rocks with some grass, some bushes behind them, and some flowers off to the side. It is actually very simple.

In fact it is so simple that almost anyone can learn to do it.!

I like to draw with a brush for the thick lines and a pen for the thin ones.

Like this:

But you could also use a thick marker and a thin one, like this:





Or you could use a pencil, like this (with no thick lines):




There is no right way to do my drawings. I like to tell people to use whatever tools they like best (but maybe not a chainsaw -- that would be too dangerous).





















How to draw GRASS and LITTLE STONES


Grass and stones are the easiest things to draw. For grass just draw a bunch of lines.



For stones, just draw a bunch of little ovals together.



How to draw CLUMPS OF FLOWERS





This step is super easy: add some small circles between everything and around the edges.


How to draw ROCKS

How to draw a couple of rocks. Although you could just draw one rock if that's what you feel like drawing.





Just add some more lines in this step -but not too many!



How to draw FLOWERS and BUSHES

Flowers are very easy. I just draw an oval with a line.



Bushes are just squiggly lines.





How to draw TREE TRUNKS



Trees are a little more difficult but the great thing is that there are no rules about what they should look like -- they could be straight or bent! Z




Putting it all together is the fun part.




Rocks, grass and bushes.
